- 2. Principal Updates Amanda Boleratz, Asst. Principal

- 3. Treasurer's Report Genie Boericke, Treasurer
  - a. Need for a budget meeting in April proposed dates that work for most?
    - Need to approve the budget for next year at the May general meeting, in advance we will have a 30-minute call for the proposed budget in April (genie and Richard to coordinate) meeting week of 22nd of April
  - b. Reimbursement Requests issues resolved with recent fixes?
